Speech of the Digital Cooperation Organization

We are committed to building a prosperous digital future for all our member states, empowering them to transition from consumers of the digital sphere to producers and innovators. As a connector, facilitator, and advisor, we ensure that everyone can participate and is equipped with the necessary tools to succeed in this new digital age.

It is here, at the Summit of the Future, that the DCO proudly launched the Digital Economy Navigator, an innovative tool that provides detailed insights on digital economy performance across 50 countries. This initiative is just one of the many ways we are turning the principles of the Global Digital Compact into action.

But while DEN is a vital resource, it is only the beginning. In the spirit of networked multilateralism, we must foster collective efforts to the GDC's ambitious goals, objectives, and commitments. I call upon every country, organization, and individual to join forces in this critical endeavor.
