Communicating for a World Where Everyone Thrives in Peace, Dignity and Equality on a Healthy Planet

RESPOND TO COVID-19 AND RECOVER BETTER

The top priority for UN communications is the response to and recovery from the pandemic. Through the 'Verified' initiative we will tackle misinformation and build confidence in health messaging and vaccination. We will mobilize resources to support equitable access to a people's vaccine. We will tell personal stories that show the impact of COVID-19 on lives and livelihoods.

As the world attempts to heal, our communications will provide hope on how we can recover better to build a more equal, inclusive, sustainable, safer and healthier planet. Our campaign 'It's Possible' will serve as a mantra during recovery and offer solutions to get the planet back on track to achieving the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the Paris Agreement. We will amplify the call to re-imagine global financing frameworks and put them at the service of humanity.

As the world tries to recover, we will demonstrate multilateralism at work and position the UN as leading on the following priority themes:

MOBILIZE FOR THE PLANET

We will frame COVID-19 as a catalyst for transforming humankind's relationship with the natural world. We will amplify the call for a Global Coalition for Carbon Neutrality, the urgent need to address diminishing biodiversity and the deteriorating state of the oceans. Our climate communications lab will show recovery as a positive, with investments in a green and sustainable global economy producing jobs, reducing emissions, and building resilience to climate impacts. We will inspire action by shining a spotlight on countries, cities, companies and citizens already leading on climate, while offering our audiences, particularly youth, opportunities to take individual actions for a healthier planet. We will position the UN as an authoritative source on climate science as well as the global leader pressing for urgent action in the lead-up to COP 26 in Glasgow, as well as the global conferences on Biodiversity and Oceans.

FIGHT INEQUALITY, STAND FOR INCLUSION

With COVID-19 preying on the most vulnerable and wiping away decades of progress, we will put a spotlight on rising poverty and inequality. We will listen to audiences who express discontent and frustration. We will be a voice for fairer, more equal societies, promoting transparency and speaking out against corruption during the recovery. We will position the UN as a beacon for inclusion, engaging audiences on issues that matter to them – racism, gender, diversity, the rights of minority groups including LGBTI, indigenous, persons with disabilities, older persons and people on the move. We will amplify the Secretary-General's Common Agenda and its vision for global governance and multilateralism that works for everyone, everywhere.

REALIZE GENDER EQUALITY

Our platforms will put women and girls front and centre as we strive to prevent COVID-19 from wiping out a generation of progress towards gender equality. We will tell individual stories of women acting as agents of change and leading the recovery. We will showcase women leaders, particularly in peace and security. We will demonstrate that the UN is walking the talk with its own representation and internal culture. We will amplify major events and initiatives, including the 65th Commission on the Status of Women and UN Women's Generation Equality.

OUR COMMUNICATIONS WILL ALSO SUPPORT THE UN AGENDA ON

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

COVID-19 has driven us farther off-course from achieving the vision and promise of the 2030 Agenda. We will amplify the Secretary-General's call for all sectors of society to get involved in a 'Decade of Action' to mobilize around the SDGs. In particular, we will spotlight the Food Systems Summit and Sustainable Transport Conference. Our communications will be designed both to educate and motivate, building a global movement of implementation. Working with our offices around the world, we will commission inspiring stories of impact and progress, creating momentum for further actions.

PEACE AND SECURITY

We will highlight the UN's role in preventing, mediating and stopping conflict including the Secretary-General's call for a global ceasefire during the pandemic. We will build support for UN peacekeeping using emotive storytelling. We will showcase the role of the UN as a convening platform for counter-terrorism and the non-proliferation of nuclear weapons. We will demonstrate the life-saving impact humanitarian workers make every day, while generating empathy for the record 235 million people worldwide in need of humanitarian assistance and protection.

HUMAN RIGHTS

We will position the UN as the voice of human rights for all, including speaking out against racism and racial discrimination. Reinforcing the Secretary-General's call to action, we will amplify the stories of human rights advocates and be a leading voice on countering the spread of hate speech, and on the sanctity of religious sites. We will encourage specific actions of solidarity.
