at the SDG Moment 2021 as part of the 76th session of the United Nations General Assembly

Thank you for hosting this event.

The COVID-19 <u>pandemic</u> has set us back also with respect to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals. It is therefore all the important that we take <u>resolute action</u> <u>now</u>.

This global crisis is also an opportunity to make our lives and economies <u>more</u> <u>sustainable</u>. We want to use the recovery from the pandemic to achieve a <u>transformation</u> to genuine sustainability.

It is clearer than ever before that we must implement the <u>2030</u> <u>Agenda more</u> <u>swiftly</u>. We will not be able to make up

for our shortcomings now in a few years' down the line.

It is also for this reason that we have continued to develop our <u>Sustainable</u> <u>Development Strategy</u> in Germany this year. Moreover, the Federal Government presented its second voluntary national review in July.

Climate protection is, at the end of the day, a question of <u>intergenerational</u> <u>equity</u>. The <u>Federal Constitutional Court</u> emphasised this with a landmark decision in March.

Our Climate Change Act is therefore now even more ambitious: Germany intends to be <u>climate-neutral</u> by <u>2045</u>. In so doing, we are also sending an important signal for the climate conference in <u>Glasgow</u>.

We will also advocate ambitious targets at the <u>Biodiversity</u> <u>Conference</u> in October.

<u>Sustainability</u> touches <u>all</u> areas of life and work. It is a task for society <u>as a</u> <u>whole</u>. It is for this reason that the involvement of interest groups and affected parties in the United Nations High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development is so important.

We must safeguard the future of the planet and the future of younger generations. This task should be the highest <u>priority</u> for us all. We have a clear agenda for this after all.

We – the international community and the United Nations – must now do our utmost to work to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals.
