WRITTEN INPUT BY THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE BAHAMAS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ON MANDATE IMPLEMENTATION FOR THE INFORMAL AD HOC WORKING GROUP ON MANDATE IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW

The Permanent Mission of The Bahamas to the United Nations expresses its appreciation to the Co-Chairs of the Working Group for their continued efforts to promote transparency and inclusiveness throughout the Working Group's process. The advanced circulation of meeting schedules and the provision of timely, substantive briefings have been particularly valuable to small and vulnerable states such as ours, which often face capacity constraints in navigating the growing volume and complexity of mandates within the United Nations system.

In this regard, The Bahamas wishes to offer the following inputs for the Co-Chairs' consideration, aimed at strengthening the overall implementation of mandates and ensuring equitable support for all Member States:

- Support the expansion of the UN Mandate Source Registry, currently serving as a beta version of an implementation framework, into a comprehensive system that tracks progress, resources, and outcomes.
- Advocate that all mandates include an accompanying resource plan, both financial and human, prior to implementation.
- Support a streamlined evaluation process to periodically assess mandate delivery and effectiveness, offering early insight into challenges without creating additional bureaucratic burden.
- Emphasize the importance of inclusive implementation support, ensuring that SIDS and small states have access to Secretariat assistance, simplified reporting tools, and regional coordination mechanisms.
