Non-eligible may mean either non-eligible refugee children or non-refugee children. It is relevant that in Jordan non-refugee children in Agency schools are offset against refugee pupils attending government schools, free of charges including secondary schools; that in the Syrian Arab Republic some

refugee pupils attend government elementary and preparatory schools and those who proceed to secondary education attend government secondary schools, in both oases free of charge; that in Gaza some teachers are provided by the Gaza Education Department for UNRWA/UNESCO schools and refugee children who proceed to secondary education attend government schools, free of charge; and that in Lebanon it has not proved feasible to collect fees from the small number of non-eligible refugee children and no arrangements have been made with the Government for offsetting the small number of non-refugee children in Agency schools.
