A recent study by Northwestern University found that 26 per cent of independent Arab filmmakers are women, while only 8 per cent of the directors of 2018's top 250 films in the US were women. Some female Arab directors have a higher international profile than men working in the region - including Lebanon's Nadine Labaki, whose Oscar-nominated and Cannes prize-winning film Capernaum. Another first-time Arab female filmmaker, Syrian journalist Waad Al Khateab, who co-directed For Sama, is now tipped for the Oscars, after the film won four British Independent Film Awards.
