## "International Parliamentarians and the Question of Palestine"

Thursday, 12 November 2020, 10.00 a.m. - 12.00 p.m. (NY Time)

The <u>UN Palestinian Rights Committee</u> will organize the Virtual Event "International Parliamentarians and the Palestine Question" on **12 November 2020 from 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.** (New York Time), via WebEx. The event will also be livestreamed on UN Web TV.

The event will be organised as a panel discussion including three parliamentarians – María Arena (European Union), Mandla Mandela (South Africa), Betty McCollum (United States) – to support the attainment of the inalienable rights of the Palestinian people and promote a just resolution of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict in peace and security. The event will highlight how efforts within national constituencies have translated into concrete actions at the national and international levels and will identify impediments to moving forward.

Participants will consist of Committee Members and the panellist parliamentarians. All Member States, intergovernmental and civil society organizations as well as the public and media will be invited to follow the event and pose questions.
