
As part of the holistic response to the COVID-19, the FSS is working to support and protect small productive institutions from closing, or critically. downsizing their activities, to mitigate damage to women and men's livelihoods.

As an immediate response to food insecurity, and to also help

preserve a viable environment for livelihood support interventions, FSS partners is continues to scale up food evouchers, in-kind food distribution where feasible and recommended, and cash assistance, including multi-purpose cash/vouchers.

Finally, the FSS response also supports advocacy initiatives focused on settler violence and impact of demolitions of livelihood assets on food insecurity, as well as on the right of Palestinians to access natural resources and maintain assets.

The FSS is working in cooperation with line ministries, to jointly agree on modalities for building local capacities to shape a coordinated and inclusive environment, ensuring consistency among humanitarian and interventions.


