MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA H.E. JOKO WIDODO ON THE OCCASION OF THE OBSERVANCE OF THE INTERNATIONAL DAY OF SOLIDARITY WITH THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE NEW YORK, 29 NOVEMBER 2021

To this end, I would like to reiterate the importance of continued support by the international community for the attainment of a two-state solution, in accordance with the internationally agreed parameters.
