

oPt emergency appeal requirement



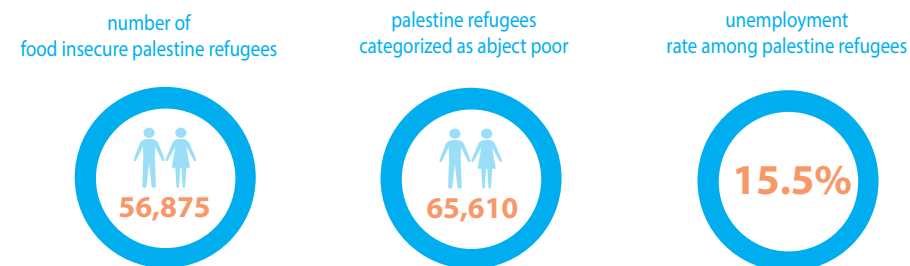
In 2019, UNRWA continued to face an unprecedented financial crisis as well as major challenges to its mandate in securing the resources needed to provide humanitarian assistance to Palestine refugees in the West Bank.

The downward trend in funding faced by the 2018 oPt Emergency Appeal, down by US\$ 100 million in 2017, continued into 2019. The US\$ 138 million needed to cover the costs of UNRWA emergency interventions in the oPt, were only funded up to US\$ 74.8 million in October 2019, only 54 per cent of total financial requirements.

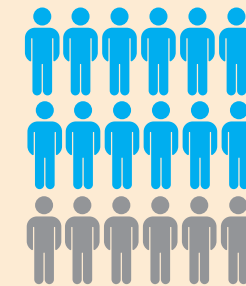
