DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE JEWS IN THE CYPRUS CAMPS

Proposal Submitted by the Delegation of Yugoslavia

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

HAVING regard to the urgent necessity of finding an early solution to the problem of Jewish displaced persons, and in view of the particularly difficult conditions under which the Jews interned in the concentration camps on the island of Cyprus are at present living,

RECOMMENDS:

That those Jewish refugees now existing under intolerable conditions in the camps of Cyprus shall be admitted to Palestine immediately governing Jewish immigration into Palestine.
