AD HOC COMMITTEE ON THE PALESTINIAN QUESTION AMENDMENTS TO REPORT OF SUB-COMMITTEE I (A/AC.14/34)

SUBMITTED BY THE DELEGATION OF PAKISTAN

PART I

- Page 3 In clause 4 of Section A, for the words "adoption by the 1. General Assembly of recommendation on the question of Palestine", substitute the following: "termination of the Mandate".
- Page 4 For clause 1 of Section B, substitute the following: 2. "A Commission shall be set up consisting of five members. The members of the Commission, no two of whom shall be nationals of the same state, shall be elected on as broad a geographical basis as possible".
- Page 9 In clause 8, Chapter 2 of Section C: after the words 3. "public purposes" in line 2, the rest of the sentence should be deleted.
- Page 12 In clause 14 of Section D, after the word "equally" in 4. line 5, delete the rest of the clause and the whole of the next sub-clause.
- Page 14 Clause 2 of Section E should be deleted. 5.

PART II

- 6. Pages
 - 14 18 For the whole of Part II of Sub-Committee I's proposal, substitute the following: "The boundaries of the Arab and Jewish States shall be recommended by a Commission composed of three boundary experts appointed by the Security Council so as:
 - (a) Not to include within the boundaries of the Arab State more Jewish-owned lands than would constitute ten per cent of the total area of the State; exclusive of state and waste lands;
 - (b) Not to include within the boundaries of the Jewish State more Arab-owned lands than would constitute ten per cent of the total area of the State, exclusive of state and waste lands. /For the purpose

For the purpose of demarcating the boundaries, the lands cultivated by the Beer-Sheba Bedouins within the Sub-District of Beer-Sheba shall be regarded as Arab owned lands.

The recommendations of the Boundary Commission shall become effective as scon as they have been approved by the Security Council."
