Sir,

The Communist Party of Palestine herewith asks to be invited
to submit written and oral testimony before the Committee. Our
Memorandum will be submitted in a few days hence. The Communist
Party wants to testify on the situation in Palestine and to outline
the Party's proposal for a solution of the Palestine Problem.

The Communist Party represents wide circles of workers, arti-
sans and working intelligentsia of the population. The Party is re-
presented in the Elected Assembly of the Jewish Community, in the
Executive Council of the General Federation of Jewish Labour, in va-
rious trade unions committees, in the Local Council of Nahariya and
in all elected institutions of the Ex-Servicemen Association. The
Party's Daily "KOL HAAM" is distributed in about 5000 copies.

The Party had applied to be invited to testify before the
Political Committee of the General Assembly of UNO on its Special
Session on Palestine in May 1947.
