Dear Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the Executive of the General Council (Vaad Leumi) of the Jewish Community of Palestine, has prepared the following memoranda:

1. "Three Historical Memoranda" (with Graphic Atlas of Historical Palestine attached) as follows:
 - (a) The Number and Density of the Population of Ancient Palestine
 - (b) The Jewish Population in Palestine from the Fall of the Jewish State to the Beginning of the Zionist Pioneering
 - (c) The Waves of Jewish Immigration into Palestine (640-1882)
2. The Jewish Community of Palestine and Its Social Services, as follows:
 - (a) The Organisation of the Jewish Community in Palestine
 - (b) The Jewish Social Services in Palestine (Education, Health and Social Welfare).
3. Local Government in Palestine.
4. Government Budgetary and Fiscal Policy.
5. Defence Regulations in Palestine.

The "Three Historical Memoranda" and Graphic Atlas of Historical Palestine, each in 30 copies, is forwarded to you herewith, and the rest of the memoranda will be submitted during the coming week.

We should be grateful if you would kindly appoint a time for the representatives of the Vaad Leumi to give evidence before the Committee.
