







Health access and attacks on healthcare









In the first quarter of 2023, there were 78 attacks on health care in the oPt, recorded and verified across oPt in WHO's Surveillance System for Attacks on Health Care (SSA).

There were **75 health attacks in the West Bank including East Jerusalem**.

- 3 in East Jerusalem
- 72 in the West Bank outside East Jerusalem

As a result of attacks, there were 70 ambulances and other vehicles affected (62 obstructed, 10 damaged, 4 targeted not damaged, 4 searched, 3 used as shield, 1 detained); at least 66 health workers affected (24 injured, 12 targeted not injured, 19 obstructed, 3 searched, 7 verbally abused or intimidated, 4 arrested or detained); and 3 health care facilities affected.

There were 3 health attacks in the Gaza Strip:

As a result of these attacks, there were 2 health workers affected (physically and verbally attacked) and 1 health facility affected, while 1 patient and 1 patient companion were arrested while traveling to access health care.
