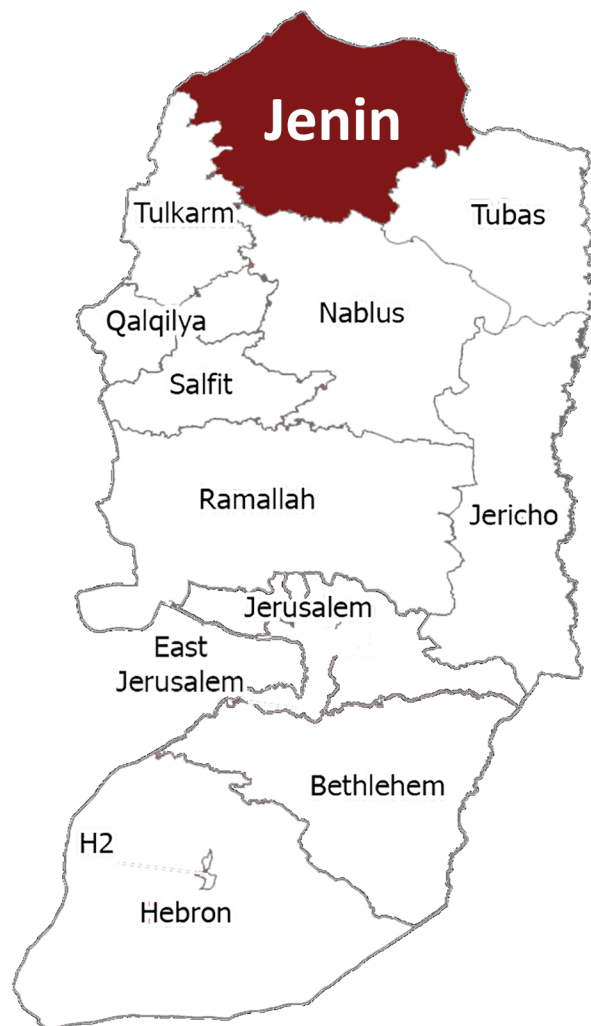




Israeli Armed Forces launched a large-scale air and ground operation in Jenin Camp at approximately 01:00 AM on 3 July 2023. Confrontations continued with Palestinian armed groups inside the camp through 4 July. This Dashboard presents updated information on the shelter cluster's activities, needs and responses provided by organizations until report date.

Shelter Response

UNRWA responses for the displaced families

- Rental subsidy: for three months, second payment after assessment for an additional 3 months with maximum coverage 6 months .
- One-time Personal belonging loss assistance for displaced families

Gap

- Assistance gap for displaced families:
 - **70 HHs** need rental subsidy for additional 6 months until reconstruction completed with total amount **\$ 189,000**
- Assistance gap for damage repair:
 - Major damage assistance: **\$ 600,000**
 - Minor damage assistance: **\$ 600,000**

Total damage repair assistance gap: \$ 1,200,000
