The Committee on the Exercise of the Inalienable Rights of the Palestinian People will convene the *Conference of Civil Society Organisations working on the Question of Palestine "Building Bridges with International Civil Society to Address the Ongoing Nakba"* on 3 and 4 April 2024 (10 a.m. - 1 p.m. & 3 – 5.30 p.m.) in Room XVII of the Palais des Nations at the United Nations Office at Geneva.

In light of the Israeli military onslaught launched against the Gaza Strip following the attacks of 7 October 2023, the Conference will focus on the role of civil society worldwide in advocating for a durable ceasefire and in achieving accountability for Israel's war crimes in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem. The event will aim to leverage CSO networks to promote objectives common with the mandate of the Committee and to further advance partnerships and joint initiatives.

The speakers include civil society representatives from Palestinian human rights organizations as well as representatives of solidarity movements in Africa, Europe, Latin America and the United States.

All Member States and Observers, United Nations organizations, intergovernmental and civil society organizations have been invited to attend. **The meeting is open to the media.** The proceedings will also be webcast at http://webtv.un.org.
