IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ATTENDEES

Venue and Dates

The International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People will take place in **the ECOSOC Chamber**, UN Headquarters, on **26 November** from **10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m**. The United Nations complex is located on 1st Avenue between 42nd and 48th Streets. All participants are required **to enter through the UN Visitors Entrance located on 1st Avenue between 45th and 46th Streets**. Once inside, attendees will proceed straight through the main corridor and take the lifts on the left, after passing through another security check. They will be able to **enter the ECOSOC Chamber from the 3rd floor.**

Grounds Pass and Access Information

All registered attendees (via www.un.org/unispal) require a

- UN ID pass (external guests). They may be collected at UN ID pass office on 1st avenue @ 45 street on 25 November from 10:00am-4:00pm. Registered attendees must bring their passport or government-issued photo ID to collect the Grounds Pass.
- A secondary pass (Delegates and UN staff-ground-pass holders). Passes may be collected at UNHQ- Visitor's lobby, Sputnik area on Monday 25 November from 10:00am-3:00pm.

UN secondary passes in addition to any permanent UN pass they may already possess, must be worn at all times within United Nations premises. Please note that the passes are non-transferable and cannot be replaced if lost or misplaced.

All attendees will be required to go through security screening prior to entering the UN premises. You should allow at least half an hour for the security screening. Please note that posters, flags, banners, and clothing with political messages will not be allowed on the premises.

Within United Nations premises, all persons are required to comply with safety and security regulations, as well as the rules and procedures of the organization. Any act that disrupts the normal functioning of the organization's programmatic activities, such as public displays of any form, including, but not limited to, clothing, banners, placards or other written or visual means, as well as vocal/audio sounds, gatherings, or demonstrations of any kind, including passive, is not allowed.

All individuals present on the United Nations premises are expected to fully cooperate with United Nations security officers. Refusal to comply with applicable regulations may result in temporary detention or removal from or denial of access to the premises in accordance with Section 10 of the United Nations Headquarters Agreement and ST/AI/2019/5, entitled "Authority of United Nations Security Officers".

Seating

Registered external guests and NGOs will be seated on the upper balcony section, entering from the 3rd floor. We **recommend arriving early** to ensure you get a seat that is comfortable for you. Please note that food and beverages are not allowed inside the ECOSOC Chamber.

Accessibility for People with Disabilities

There is an access ramp at the 46th Street and 1st Avenue Visitors' Entrance, and elevators inside the building. The UN can reserve specific seats for persons on wheelchairs, please let us know when you collect your Grounds Pass if you require such an accommodation.
