AT THE

HIGH-LEVEL CONFERENCE FOR THE PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT ON THE QUESTION OF PALESTINE AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TWO-STATE SOLUTION

NEW YORK

JULY 29TH 2025

Thank you, Co-Chairs,

Excellencies,

- 1. Let me begin by **thanking the Government of France and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia** for convening this **vital conference**, on implementing **the Two-State Solution**.
- 2. We are here today to stand for humanity.
- 3. To demand **justice for the Palestinian people**.
- 4. To push for a **lasting solution**, to the **most protracted conflict in United Nations's history**.
- 5. For over seven decades, Palestinians have been denied their right to independence.
- 6. Today, they are being **denied not only freedom...** but the **right to live as human being**. The right to exist.
- 7. Every day, the **toll of human suffering rises**.
- 8. <u>Civilians perish</u> while queuing for **food**.
- 9. The very fabric, of Palestinian society is **being torn apart**.
- 10. When food aid becomes a death sentence, how much worse must it get before we act?
- 11. We have all **spoken loudly**. **We have condemned**.
- 12. But now we must ask: how much longer will we allow this to continue?
- 13. How many more lives must be lost, **before the multilateral system fulfills** its purpose, to uphold peace and justice?

Excellencies,

- 13.Indonesia is **proud to co-chair the Roundtable on Security**, with Italy.
- 14. We bring the voice of solidarity, of principle, and of action.
- 15. This conference must be more than **another UN gathering**.
- 16.It must be a **rallying point for global conscience**.
- 17. The future must not be a one-state reality, built on annexation and apartheid.
- 18.It must be a Two-State Solution, where Israel and Palestine living side by side in peace and security within recognized borders, based on the 1967 lines, in accordance with international law, UN resolutions, and international agreements.
- 19.We therefore welcome, **the Joint Statement and leadership** of nearly 30 countries **calling for an end**, to the war and humanitarian crisis in Gaza.
- 20.We also welcome **other recent global initiatives** supporting the State of Palestine.
- 21. These efforts must be the spark, not the ceiling, of our ambition.
- 22. Against there backdrop, let me highlight three essential points.
- 23. FIRST, Recognition is not symbolic. It is strategic.
- 21. Recognizing Palestine is not a favor. It is a duty under international law.
- 22. To recognize Palestine is to stand for justice.
- 23. It is to believe in the **UN Charter**.

- 24. It is to level the diplomatic playing field.
- 25.A two-state solution begins with political recognition.
- 26.Only then can genuine **peace negotiations take place**.
- 27.Only then can we **end the illegal occupation**, as confirmed by the **International Court of Justice**.
- 28. SECOND, hostilities must end.
- 26.A ceasefire is not a tactic. **It is a moral imperative**.
- 27. Humanitarian aid must flow. Civilians must be protected. Dialogue must begin. Violence must end.
- 28.Our Roundtable made one thing clear: **peace requires security**, **for both Palestinians and Israelis**.
- 29.**President Prabowo** has affirmed Indonesia's readiness to **contribute to peace**, including through providing personnel to support stabilization efforts in Gaza, **under a UN mandate**.
- 30.We are not just advocating peace, we are ready to help build it, on the ground.
- 31. THIRD, the future of Palestine must be Palestinian-led.
- 30.Rebuilding Gaza and shaping its political future **must be owned by the Palestinian people**.
- 31. No one can build a state for Palestine... only Palestinians can.
- 32. Any attempt to forcibly displace them or impose conditions on their sovereignty, <u>must be firmly rejected</u>.

- 33.A strong, **unified State of Palestine**, with full control over its territory and institutions, **is the foundation of sustainable peace**.
- 34. Only then can Israel truly be welcomed as a peaceful neighbor in a secure Middle East.
- 35.Despite the devastation, **Indonesia continues** to invest in Palestinian youth, **particularly through education**.
- 36.**Because we believe**: one day, **these young people** will lead a free, democratic, and sovereign Palestine.

Excellencies,

- 37. The time has come for **decisive**, **irreversible steps** to realize the Two-State Solution.
- 38.Indonesia stands ready to work with all countries to this end.
