

Summary

In September 2025, 29.2K metric tonnes (t) of humanitarian aid processed through the UN2720 Mechanism were delivered to Kerem Shalom/Karem Abu Salem, Erez West/Zikim, or Kissufim crossings. This is a 4% decrease in delivered aid compared to August 2025 (30.4K t), and a 173% increase compared to the monthly average since April 2024 (10.7K t). In September, 62% of the total aid tonnage was delivered via Israel (including through Ashdod and Ben Gurion), 16% via Egypt, 10% via the Jordan Corridor, 9% via the West Bank, and 3% via Cyprus. In September, over 8,200 t of aid reached its intended civilian destination, exceeding the total delivered to the intended civilian destination in June, July, and August combined (over 6,400 t).

Out of the total 191.7K t overall aid delivered through the Mechanism, food constitutes most of the consignments (75%) followed by shelter (16%) and WASH (6%) items. As of 30 September, a total of over 182K t (over 268K pallets) of aid is in the pipeline of the UN2720 Mechanism, approved by COGAT (including Ready to Dispatch) but still pending delivery to Gaza.

Since the limited resumption of humanitarian aid movements on 19 May, all UN-manifested aid has been tracked and monitored by UN2720 through a combination of on-the-ground Monitors and cross-verification with partners. UN2720 Monitors continue to verify the collection and delivery of aid to its intended civilian destination within Gaza, subject to access permissions.





**Gaza Humanitarian Aid Monitoring Overview**

Since the resumption of UN-manifested humanitarian aid movements in May 2025, UN2720 Monitors have been central to ensuring transparency, accountability, and credibility in the delivery of assistance to Gaza. Their role spans both the verification of consignments at border crossings and the oversight of storage and handling within warehouses. By directly observing and documenting aid movements, Monitors, where possible, ensure that humanitarian supplies are tracked at every stage from entry into Gaza to preparation for delivery to civilians.


UN2720 Monitors have conducted 325 monitoring missions, including 208 at the Kerem Shalom border crossing, 114 at warehouses (either for the UN or INGO partners), and one during loading operations in Cyprus. The Cyprus operation involved direct inspection of 454 pallets, approximately 140 t of Household Food Items. In total, UN2720 tracked approximately 47,426 pallets from 324 aid requests, encompassing food and nutrition, health, WASH, and shelter supplies (including tents), and items for operational support.

Overview: 26 April 2024 – 30 September 2025



UN Security Council Resolution 2720 (2023) mandated the establishment of the UN2720 Mechanism for Gaza with the objective of accelerating the provision of humanitarian relief consignments to Gaza. The UN Office for Project Services (UNOPS) is responsible for the operation and management of the UN2720 Mechanism for Gaza. Data collection for the Cyprus Maritime Corridor route started on 26 April 2024. Data collection for the Jordanian Corridor and other routes started on 1 September 2024. This report presents data on aid delivered to Gaza through the UN2720 Mechanism, not the total of aid to Gaza. The numbers expressed in this report reflect data available and are subject to change, reflecting the movement of consignments and the dynamic nature of the context. All data as of 30 September 2025.

* "Under process" is the number of requests currently under Desk Review by the Mechanism or pending a decision by COGAT, and does not include approved, rejected, or cancelled requests.

** Critical Humanitarian Items (CHI) are considered dual use items by Israel. Excludes time taken when requests are pending further action from Consignors.
