BACKGROUND

The European Union Association was granted Special Consultative Status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) in 2012. These events have been held in cooperation with various partners, including: European Union representatives, European Union countries, NGOs, academic experts, civil-rights activists, and the Division for Social Policy and Development (DSPD) under the Department of Economic and Social Affairs (DESA).

The Union for the Mediterranean (UfM) is an intergovernmental Euro-Mediterranean organization that brings together all 28 countries of the European Union and 15 countries of the Southern and Eastern Mediterranean. The 10th anniversary of its founding offers a unique opportunity for us to celebrate it with an open and informative platform and events that present its workings, challenges and achievements.



CONCEPT

International cooperation for peaceful development is better served via institutions that bring together representatives from different countries who try to find common ground and approaches to social, economic and development problems.

The Mediterranean Sea Area is a strategically important part of the world that is at a crossroad between East and West, North and South.

Representatives from civil society organizations, diplomats, students will have an opportunity to discuss common problems and opportunities counter divisive tendencies based on resurgent nationalism informing future leaders of tomorrow and the international community at the UN of the positive aspects of globalization and regional cooperation.
