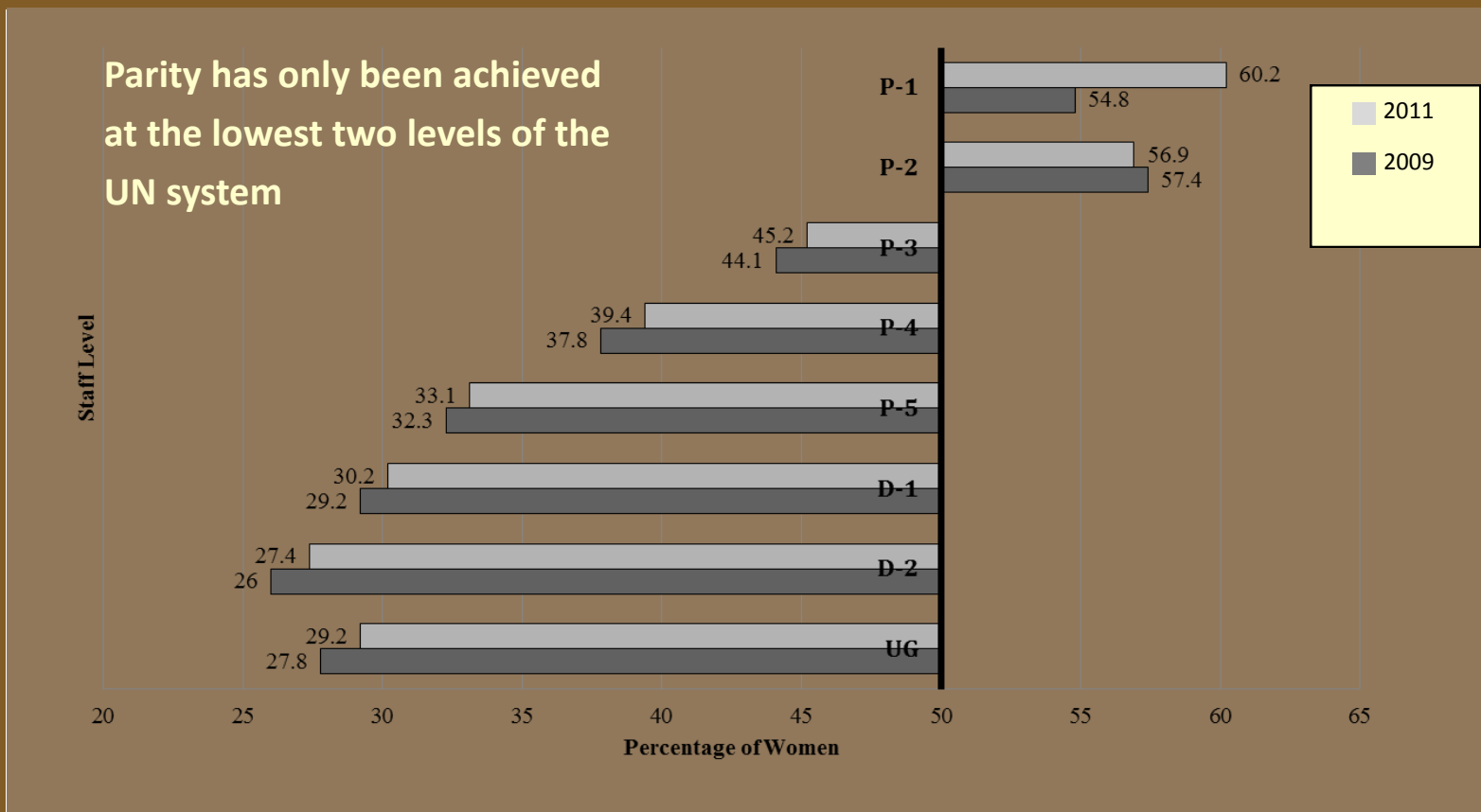


2011: The Status of Women in the UN

The proportion of women has grown by 0.8 per cent since 2009, but the growth rate has almost halved



The proportion of women on contracts of one year or more increased in 16 entities and decreased in 11, and only ICJ, PAHO, UNFPA, UNICEF and UNW achieved parity
