

### 1997

A/RES/51/67 calls upon the Secretary-General to achieve the overall goal of gender parity, particularly at the Professional level and above, by the year 2000

#### 1996

A/RES/50/164 calls upon the Secretary-General to fulfill his target, reaffirmed by the Fourth World Conference on Women, or having women hold 50 per cent of managerial and decision-making positions by the year 2000

# 1990

A/RES/45/239 urges the Secretary-General to focus on women's representation at the D-1 level and above in order to achieve 25 per cent representation of women in decision-making roles and 35 per cent at all other levels in posts subject to geographical distribution in

# 1986

A/RES/41/206 requests the Secretary-General to take the necessary measures to achieve 30 per cent women's representation in posts subject to geographical distribution in the Secretariat by 1990

### 2011

UN Women is created and its functions include: monitoring system-wide compliance with intergovernmental mandates on gender balance, and efforts to develop and apply gender equality policies (including gender balance, eliminating harassment and promoting work-life balance)

### 1997

The Secretary-General establishes the Office of the Special Adviser for Gender Issues and the Advancement of Women to monitor mandates related to gender balance. In 2001, OSAGI's re-
